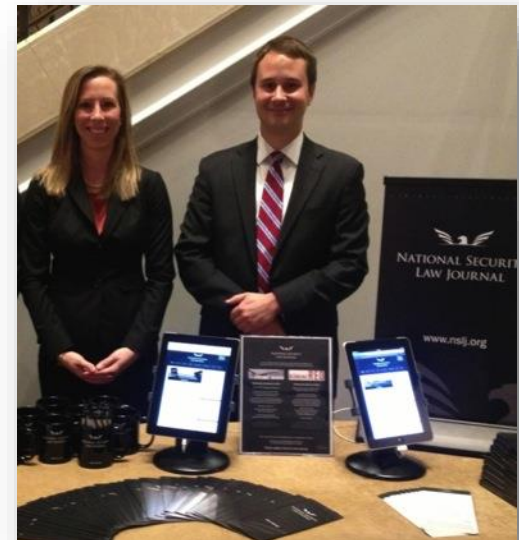

- We also host or co-sponsor other selected events

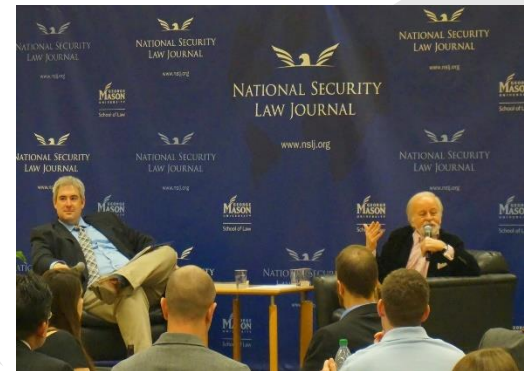
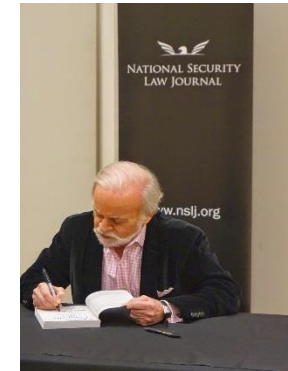
